## **DISTRICT 2 FINALS GUIDELINES**

**The first two Open and Nursery classes are USBCHA sanctioned and open to all handlers from any district.**

**The District 2 Nursery Champion will be determined based on the average of 2 Nursery runs.**

**The District 2 Open Champion will be the winner of the Double Lift to be held on June 1, 2015. Only qualifying District 2 dogs will run in the double lift and a handler can only qualify 2 dogs, even if they run 3 in the open class.**

**Qualifying criteria: Top 4 District 2 dogs from each open trial plus top 4 combined scores (not to include dogs that qualify as the top 4). If a dog is in the top 4 both days, the 5th place dog from day 2 will qualify. If there 2 dogs that qualify on both days, we will take the sixth place dog from day 1, and so forth until there are 8 dogs. We will then take the 4 dogs with the high combined scores, again not including already qualified dogs.**

**We will need volunteers to help with the Double Lift Final and hope that handlers from other districts will stay and help.**
