Rules: All applicable rules concerning the trial itself, course map, and running order will be posted /revealed the day of the trial. By signing the entry form, handler agrees to read and adhere to all trial rules.

- 1) By signing the Sublette County Fair Sheep Dog Trial Entry Form, the competitor is responsible for making sure that ALL dogs brought to the facility are fully vaccinated.
- 2) Competitors must be respectful of the judge, announcer, volunteers and trial organizers at all times. Trial organizers reserve the right to disqualify competitors for unsportsmanlike behavior.
- 3) Competitors must be in control of their dog(s) at all times. The Judge will excuse or disqualify (at his/her discretion) a competitor for a dog out of control or roughing the stock.
- 4) Remember that we have an audience. The Judge and the trial organizers will take any steps necessary to ensure the safety of the stock and the dogs, competitors are expected to do the same.
- 5) All entries, in each respective class, will run the same course and have the same time limit.
- 6) Stock may vary (ewes and lambs), and may be recirculated (depending on entry numbers and sheep availability).
- 7) ALL classes will be judged on *Points and Time*.
- 8) Payout Checks will be determined by the number of entries, and given to handlers the day of the trial. No Payout to Novice Class.
- 9) The objective of this trial is to have fun, showcase your dogs, and provide a fun/educational source of entertainment to the residents/visitors of this great community. Do what is needed to make sure it is a good experience for your dog.
- 10) TRIAL ORGANIZERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REVIEW SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES AS THEY ARISE.

AN EXAMPLE OF POINTS AND TIME JUDGING:

- 1) Each sheep that completes each obstacle will receive 5 points;
- 2) The number and type of obstacles will vary depending on class, and will end with a pen.
- 3) Handler has the right to continue on and take points earned. Example: If only two sheep complete an obstacle the handler would receive 10 points and can continue on with three sheep to the next obstacle, or go back and use more time to try and get all three through the obstacle.
- 4) Score is determined by the highest number of points and the fastest time.
